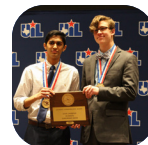

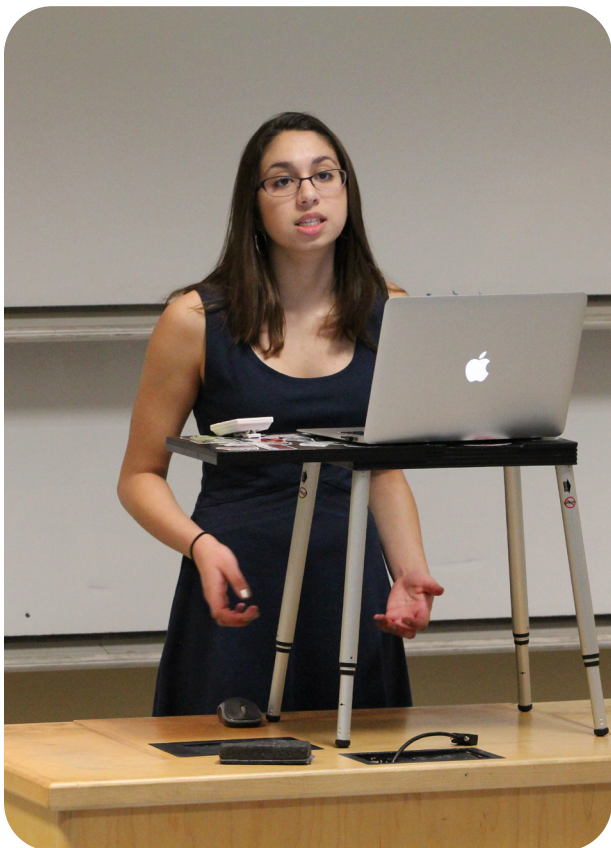

What is TILF?

The Texas Interscholastic League Foundation (TILF) is a public charity that solicits donations and disburses scholarships to deserving UIL Academic participants.

100% of donated funds go to student scholarships.



Who Can Apply?

Students who meet the following criteria:

- ★ Must have competed at the UIL Academic, Congressional Debate, Cross Examination Debate, One-Act Play, or Theatrical Design State Meet **OR** must have been a state finalist in the Barbara Jordan Historical Essay Competition, the Latino History Essay Competition, or the UIL Young Filmmakers Festival **OR** must have been a member of one of the top 10 teams per competition group at the BEST or FIRST state robotics contests at any point in their high school career
- ★ Must plan to attend an accredited college or university in the state of Texas
- ★ Must plan to enroll as a full-time college student in the fall 2024 semester
- ★ Must be graduating from high school during the current year

How To Apply

Complete the online application between March 1 and May 24, 2024, including the submission of:

- ★ Your high school transcript
- ★ Your SAT/ACT scores (if taken)
- ★ A letter of recommendation from an administrator, UIL coach, teacher, or counselor
- ★ A copy of the first two pages of your parent or guardian's most recent IRS 1040 form
- ★ A copy of your college financial aid letter
